2021 NEW PAYLOADER FINANCING PROPOSALS

Trustee Jusko discussed major repairs that are needed to be made with regard to the existing payloader truck utilized by the Highway Department, such as replacing a broken piston and a need for new tires. In addition, the existing payloader has reached its useful life of 19 years and approximately 5000 driven hours. Trustee Jusko presented the following financing scenarios for the purchase of a new payloader from Caterpillar from a NYS contract without the requirement of competitive bidding:

5 year

Year 1=\$27,500 trade in value of existing payloader Years 2-5=\$34,349.78Total cost \$164,899.12

6 year

Year 1= \$27,500 trade in value of existing payloader Years 2-6 = \$27,813.54 Total cost \$166,567.70

7 year

Year 1 = \$27,500 trade in value of existing payloader Years 2-7 = \$23,458.24Total cost \$168,249.44

The Board agreed that in the current low interest rate environment, the 7-year option, with lower annual payments, is preferable. The Clerk advised that next year's payment can be made from existing Capital Funds. Mayor DeVita moved to approve the purchase of a new payloader from Caterpillar, NYS contract # 40625, at a total cost of \$168,249.44, with a trade-in of the existing payloader used as the first annual payment, valued at \$27,500, and financing of the balance, with the 7-year option as presented above, seconded by Trustee Jusko, and approved by the following poll of the Board:
