VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 135 OF THE VILLAGE CODE

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Inc. Village of Laurel Hollow, in the County of Nassau, as follows:

<u>FIRST</u>: Section 135-19 of the Code of the Inc. Village of Laurel Hollow is hereby repealed and replaced with a new Section 135-19 as follows:

Every person convicted of a traffic infraction for a violation of any provision of this chapter which is not a violation of any provision of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York shall, for a first conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$250, or by imprisonment for not more than 15 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment; for a second such conviction within 18 months thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$350, or by imprisonment for not more than 45 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment; upon a third or subsequent conviction within 18 months after the first conviction, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$450 or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this local law is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this local law.

THIRD: Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided by law.
