Friends of the Bay will be hosting an event on Tuesday October 25th at 7:00pm at the Oyster Bay Brewing Company (36 Audrey Avenue, Oyster Bay). Officials from The Nature Conservancy will be giving updates on various environmental issues, including water quality, marine fisheries and more. Friends of the Bay is a non-profit organization dedicated to improving the water quality in Oyster Bay and Cold Spring Harbor. They conduct important water quality monitoring tests throughout the year, host beach clean-ups, and other activities and educational programs. They have been good partners to our Village in our efforts to improve water quality in the Sound, including, among many other things, using their water quality testing boat to move each year 150,000 plus mature oysters raised in our Community Oyster Garden Program to the oyster sanctuary just off of our beach.
