Subject: Boating Season to End Soon

Dear Fellow Boater:

The current boating season is coming to an end and the dock will be removed shortly after Thanksgiving. Please arrange for your boat, mooring, dinghy, and/or kayak to be removed before December 1st to avoid problems and to comply with Village policy.

Due to the high winds, the boat racks are a mess and some of the dinghies are now deflated. Please spend a few minutes securing your dinghies and kayaks if you intend to continue using these vessels for the time being.

We will check the boat racks after December 1st to make sure that all vessels have been removed. Please know that if the Village removes your vessel, you will be charged a fee of \$50 plus an initial storage fee of \$150. An additional storage fee of \$75 will be charged for each month that the dinghy or other vessel remains unclaimed. We obviously want to avoid the need to impose these fees and that is why we are sending this early reminder.
