Subject: Cedarwood Court Road Conditions

Dear Cedarwood Court Residents:

The Village is aware of the rapidly deteriorating condition of the road. This is unexpected in light of the fact that the road was completely reconstructed in 2015, a short time ago given the usual 20-year normal life expectancy of a road. Before we replace it, we are undertaking to understand the cause of this. Some have surmised that there is a spring or maybe underground utilities that are affecting the road. We will find the answer, and we must do so before we repave the road. Without an answer, the pave and repave cycle will continue in an unnecessarily short time frame and in an unsatisfactory manner. Meanwhile, we will keep the road maintained and patched with UPM, a higher grade asphalt material. Finding the problem, solving it, and repaving the road is our top road concern right now. Please let us know whenever new issues appear on the road.
