Subject: More Severe Storms Today Outage Information

Dear Neighbor:

We are expecting severe thunderstorms this afternoon. High wind gusts and heavy rains could lead to power and cable outages. Last week's storm split a telephone pole in half causing major outages north of Route 25A. Remember, if you see a downed wire, always, always call 911 first. Never go near one. Please keep the following information handy in the event of power or cable loss.
