Dear Neighbor:

Tomorrow from 1:00 to 2:00pm we will be hosting a press event at the Laurel Hollow Beach celebrating the conclusion of the sixth year of our Oyster Gardening Program. This community program has grown from its humble beginnings with Laurel Hollow as the lone village raising about 30,000 oysters. Now the program has expanded to Beekman Beech in Oyster Bay, West Harbor Beach in Bayville, and Eagle Dock in Cold Spring Harbor. This year we will have raised 200,000 oysters, which are being released into the oyster sanctuary just off our beach that was established by the Town of Oyster Bay 3 years ago. Town of Oyster Bay Supervisor Joseph Saladino and various Oyster Bay Council men and women will attend, as will the mayors of neighboring villages whose residents also participate in the program. Please be advised that parking in the lot between 12:00 and 2:00 pm may be difficult but you can park on Laurel Hollow Road near the Beach. Of course, if you have been involved with the program, you are welcome to participate.
